

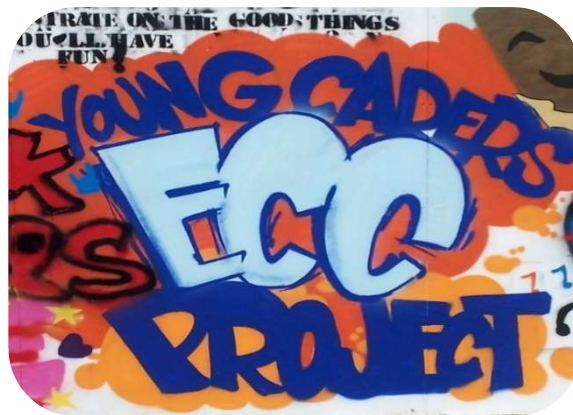
Aged 5-18 years and care for someone?

At Enfield Carers Centre, we run a **Young Carers Project** known as Enfield Young People In Caring (**EyPIC**).

EyPIC provide support to children and young people **aged 5-18 who have a caring role.**

This is a **FREE** service.

We provide respite activities, personal support, and help with schoolwork to young carers aged 5-18 who help look after someone in their family who has an illness, disability, mental health condition, or misuses drugs or alcohol.
