At Enfield Carers Centre, we run a **Young Carers Project** known as Enfield Young People In Caring (**EyPIC**).

EyPIC provide support to children and young people aged 5-18 who have a caring role.

This is a **FREE** service.

We provide respite activities, personal support, and help with schoolwork to young carers aged 5-18 who help look after someone in their family who has an illness, disability, mental health condition, or misuses drugs or alcohol.



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Supporting Young Carers

We offer:

- 1-2-1 support meetings and mentoring
- A homework club (both in person and online)
- A range of group activities including drama workshops, craft sessions, chats, and yoga (both in person and online)
- Exciting trips (to places such as Jump In, the cinema, and others!)
- Support, advice, and information to young carers and their families
- We can also attend meetings at school to discuss educational support
