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The National Garden Scheme has kindly allocated us 10 places for Carers to visit a local garden free of charge! The visit will take place on Saturday 31st May at 11.00am. Carers would need to travel there independently but we can refund your reasonable travel expenses.

The garden is based in King Edward Road in Waltham Cross, EN8 and is a small courtyard garden transformed into an 'urban jungle' with many exotic trees and shrubs.

Its owner is Bryan Hewitt who drew inspiration from working for many years at nearby Myddelton House, the garden designed by famous horticulturist, E A Bowles. Walls are clad with a collection of vintage advertising signs and statuary and architectural salvage lurk in shady alleys. Every corner tells a story.
